



What is NES?

The updated version of Sychrotize was recorded with a live audience in Lincoln City, Oregon in July 2007. The new version features clear, professional audio recordings and new information from Adamus Saint-Germain.

What is the difference between studying NES on my own and taking an NES class from a certified teacher?

Please understand that a personal experience is no substitute for attending a high quality, teacher conducted workshop when working with this material or if you choose to become a Shaumbra Institute certified Synchronize facilitator. These 3-day events are an invaluable way to fully immerse yourself in the teachings, share in the discussions and to learn from the personal experiences of others in your class. In the pursuit of any worthy endeavor, the company of like-minded people is a valuable support. You are warmly invited to participate in one of these New Energy Synchronize retreats, if you so choose.

I am currently listed on the Synchronize website as a facilitator. Will my name continue to be in this directory?

One major change in program content is that studying this new material on your own does not qualify you as a facilitator, and going forward, anyone choosing to be a certified NES facilitator will be required to take a teacher-led workshop.

*If you are currently listed as a facilitator we are offering a **one time opportunity** to re-qualify for the directory. To be eligible for a listing in the New Energy Synchronize directory, you must have purchased the ESS program PRIOR TO September 30, 2007 and have conducted at least three (3) client facilitations.
